**“Coming Together for the Better” 1 Corinthians 11:17-22**

1. Why is it important for us to be intentional and prepare our hearts to gather with the saints on Sunday? What can happen if we don't?
2. In what ways were the Corinthians coming together for the worse? How else might coming together for the worse look? What does it look like to come together for the better?
3. How did the Corinthian church manifest disunity? What are some ways we may be tempted to divide from one another? How does this deny the truths of the gospel?
4. How were some Corinthian believers actually pursuing self-interest in gathering together? What are some subtle ways we could be guilty of this too?
5. How can our church's mission statement to be “a gospel-centered community committed to making disciples who love Jesus Christ and love others in Jesus' name” serve as a helpful reminder as we prepare ourselves to gather on Sundays?
