“God’s Plan for Man and Woman – Part 2” 1 Corinthians 11:2-16

1. What are some of the reasons this has proven to be a difficult passage of Scripture? Why don’t we think head coverings are required for our cultural situation?

2. Why does failing to maintain culturally appropriate gender distinctions result in shame and dishonor?

3. How does the created order (Genesis 2:7, 21-23) reflect God’s intention for man and woman?

4. How do we know that submission of role does not equal inferiority of person? Why is this important to keep in mind both for those in roles of authority and for those in roles involving submission?

5. What are some subtle and not-so subtle ways our culture blurs the line between male and female? What can we do to help keep the distinction clearer?

6. How can we maintain appropriate distinctions between male and female without developing lists of “dos and don’ts” that can seem a lot like legalism?
