

LifeGroup Questions for the week of February 25, 2018
“Creation Days Four & Five: Sun, Moon, Stars, Sea Life and Birds”

1. What is the historical setting for the book of Genesis (who wrote it, why did they write it, where was it written, what were the circumstances, etc.)? How does this help us in interpreting and better understanding Genesis 1-2?

2. What is scientific naturalism? How is this worldview deficient? Why is this worldview important to understand when studying Genesis 1-2?

3. Describe some of the cultural pressures to conform our beliefs and even our interpretation of the Bible to the theories of scientific naturalism. Have you ever experienced any of these pressures?

4. What stands out to you about God’s creation of the sun, moon, and stars and the vastness of the universe on Creation day four? What impact can this have on our faith?

5. On day five, God creates sea life and birds. Read Psalm 104:24-35; Job 39:26-40:5, Job 41:1-42:6 and Matthew 6:25-26. How can reflecting on these creatures and the One who made them help us in our walk with God?
