1. Why is the historical context important for rightly understanding a book of the Bible? What is the historical context of the book of Genesis?
2. How do we know the darkness of vs. 2 wasn't evil or in opposition to God? Why might this be important?
3. What is the significance of God declaring his creation good, separating it, naming it, etc.?
4. God created light by commanding it to exist. What does this teach us about God? How does Jesus demonstrate this same kind of power and rule? How should this impact our faith?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 4:6. What does this verse have to do with Genesis 1? What is it saying about our salvation? How should we respond to this truth?
