

LifeGroup Questions for the week of April 8, 2018

“Creation Day Seven: God Completes His Work of Creation” Genesis 2:1-3

1. Relative to other ways of marking time (day, month, year), what is so unusual about a seven-day week? How might one explain its nearly universal adoption?
2. What were the three significant elements of creation day seven?
3. If God ceased His creative work on day seven then what was He doing on this day?
4. How does God’s pattern of six days working and one day of rest serve as helpful guide for our own weekly rhythms? How and why is our observance of this pattern different from Israel’s under the Mosaic Law?
5. In what ways are we tempted to ignore God’s pattern of work and rest and go our own way? Are there some practical things that can help us not to neglect this general pattern?
6. How is Jesus our ultimate Sabbath rest (Hebrews 4:1-11)? How should this truth impact us?
