

**LifeGroup Questions for the week of January 20, 2018**  
**“But God Remembered Noah” Genesis 8:1-22**

1. What does it mean that God remembered Noah? What was the basis for God remembering Noah?

2. What does it mean that God remembers us? How can God’s promises to “remember” us (Deut. 31:6; Heb. 13:15; Isa. 41:10; Matt. 28:20; John 10:27-28) encourage us when life is hard?

3. Leaving the ark, Noah’s first action was to build an altar and worship the Lord. Why do you think he did this so soon after leaving the ark? Why was this such a good and right response to what he had just been through?

4. What are some of the reasons we are sometimes slow to worship and give thanks? What can help us to sharpen our worship reflexes?

5. How do God’s promises fuel us with hope? How does biblical hope differ from the world’s understanding of hope?

6. What are some of God’s promises that have been an encouragement to you? How do these promises take us back to the idea of God remembering us?
