

LifeGroup Questions for the week of December 3, 2017
“The Miracles of Christmas: Do You Hear What I Hear?”

1. In your own words, how would you define a miracle? What are some biblical examples of miracles?

2. In what ways is divine revelation a miracle? How is the process (revelation, inspiration, preservation, illumination) of divine revelation miraculous?

3. How might the 400 silent years have been interpreted by God’s people? What does Galatians 4:4 teach us about God’s timing and these 400 years? What can that teach us about God’s providence in our own lives?

4. God’s word is powerful. What does Ezekiel 37:1-14 teach us about this power? What does Ephesians 2:1-10 teach us about our own spiritual condition and God’s power?

5. Jesus said repeatedly, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear” (Matthew 11:14; 13:9, 43; Mark 4:9, 23; 7:16; Luke 8:8; 14:35). What does this mean? Why is listening to God so important? What happens if we fail to listen? How can we listen more attentively?
