4. How does this hypothesis apply to the rest of God's creation? (See Psalm 8:3; 33:6; 92:4-5, 104:24, 111:2; 136:5-9; Nehemiah 9:6; Jeremiah 10:11-12; Col. 1:15-16; Rev. 4:11; 14:7)

5. Why is there a fundamental resistance among many to acknowledge design in the universe? What does Romans 1:18-32 teach us about this resistance?
