“Entrusted: Living a Life of Faithfulness” – Part 2, Luke 12:16-34

1. Why did God call the wealthy farmer in this parable a fool?
2. Why is an eternal perspective so important for living a life of faithfulness? How can we better cultivate and maintain an eternal perspective? Can you think of any Scriptures that would help?
3. How is anxiety a lack of faith and trust in God? How does God’s sovereignty over and ownership of all things help in the fight against anxiety?
4. What does it mean to seek God’s Kingdom first? How should this make a difference in the way we view all of our resources?
5. Why is it important for us to develop a strategy for investing our resources (time, talents, treasure) in Kingdom causes? How does Jesus’ promise in vs. 33 encourage us to make such investments?
