

LifeGroup Questions for the week of October 11, 2015
“Gospel Transformation to the Glory of God” – 1 Corinthians 1:1-3

1. Read about the founding of the church at Corinth in Acts 18:1-18. What stands out to you in this passage?
2. Find a good study bible and read the introductory material on 1 Corinthians. What did you learn? Why is an understanding of the historical and literary background of a book of the Bible helpful and important?
3. If you can, find a Bible that has chapter/paragraph headings or titles. Survey the book of 1 Corinthians by just reading these headings and titles and write down all of the issues that were facing the Corinthian church.
4. In verse 2, Paul refers to the church at Corinth as “the church of God,” “those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus,” and “saints by calling.” Given what was happening in the church, why is this significant?
5. How can a study of the book of 1 Corinthians help a believer today? How can it help the church today?
