1. According to Paul in 3:1, what was the fundamental condition of the Corinthian believers? How did this condition relate to all the other issues that the Corinthians were facing?

2. What does it mean to be governed by the flesh? How can we be governed by the Spirit instead?

3. How were the Corinthians failing to appreciate solid spiritual food? How can we grow in our appreciation for and application of solid spiritual food?

4. In what ways does divisiveness show spiritual immaturity? What practical things can help to maintain unity in the church?

5. Paul exemplified a high view of God and a low view of self. Why is this so important for spiritual maturity? How can we gain a higher view of God and a lower view of ourselves?
