

**LifeGroup Questions for the week of April 29, 2018**  
**“God’s Plan for Marriage” – Part 2 Genesis 2:24**

1. Why might the subject of biblical marriage be difficult for some people to consider and discuss? Why is it important?
2. Why is it easier to support the concept of Biblical marriage than it is to actually have a Biblical marriage (if you are married)?
3. How do we know that God’s plan for marriage is intended to be universal? What are some of the implications of this universality? Why is biblical marriage good even for unbelievers?
4. What should “leaving and cleaving” include? What are some of the common obstacles to this aspect of biblical marriage?
5. What does marriage being “one flesh” involve? How can a marriage experience more of the intimacy of this “one flesh” union?
6. In what ways does marriage point us to the gospel?
